Directions to Bluebird from the
Square in Carrollton
Turn right at the light and head south on Rt.
332. Turn left on 3rd Street by the Method-
ist Church. The Bluebird Amphitheater is
located on the left at the bottom of the hill.
Use the first driveway in front of the large
sign to drop off music campers
Arts Campers should proceed to the next
driveway on left which is the entrance to the
Bluebird Restaurant.

Children participating in the camp should
be dropped off at 9:00 am and picked up
no later than 2:15 p.m. each day at their
camping site.

Children should bring a sack lunch each
day, except Friday when they may bring
finger foods to share for the reception.

Children should dress for the weather,
wear comfortable walking shoes (no flip
flops) and clothes, and bring an old paint
shirt or apron for the art class.

Arts and Music in Appalachia

The self-sufficient crafts tradition of the Appalachian folk was necessitated by their isolation from the "modern" world.

Farmers built their homes and furniture from the abundant variety of hardwoods from the forest, sewed clothes from the animals they hunted and raised, made tools and cookware from the iron they mined and forged, crafted baskets, pottery and children's toys from nature's blessings, and made their own musical instruments.

Campers will learn this self-sufficient and self-sustaining tradition and blend it into arts and music they will learn to do themselves.

The beautiful grounds of the Bluebird Farm Park and Amphitheater is the site for these week-long camps.

MUSIC CLASSES

Local folk musicians Richard and Kathy Small will introduce Folk Music Campers to music theory and rhythm. They will then spend the week having a great time learning to play various Folk instruments including the Mountain Dulcimer, Autoharp and Harmonica.

Folk music singing and accompaniment on different instruments will also be a part of the week's agenda. Various games and fun activities will be included every day. More advanced classes will be provided for campers who have previous musical experience or training.

Campers will share their musical abilities in a unique format at a reception for family, friends and community on Friday afternoon from 1 to 3 pm.



ART CLASSES

In our summer camp program, local artist and teacher, Cheri Bell, will provide our young campers with an opportunity to explore and create their own handiwork in the "folk art" tradition.

Several local artists will lead classes allowing the students to create artworks in clay, paint, outdoor nature sketching on the beautiful Bluebird Park grounds as well as various other enrichment activities as time and weather permits.

Each student will be encouraged to explore his/her own creativity and progress on an individual basis.
